The Thinking Tools Studio and its live offering, Open Studio, are key to creating that community. The Waters Center team looks forward to a weekly email showing new TTS subscribers and their locations – an indicator that our work is spreading and impacting the world.

Currently we have over 10,500 total subscribers to TTS.

2023 brought us an additional 2,200 TTS subscribers from 103 countries.

Advanced Facilitator Credential

Our first cohort of credential candidates launched in June of 2021. AFC is an intensive one-year program to build an individual's skills in systems thinking, facilitation, and coaching.

The program continues to grow. To date, 105 people have participated in the program, with 84 of those earning a credential. Special congratulations to the members of Cohort 4 who were credentialed on November 15, 2023.


Shell NXplorers

In 2023 DaNel extended our reach to international waters when she set sail as part of an esteemed group of educators who boarded the Joides Resolution, a working research vessel, to create new teaching materials for educators around the world.
